


How to Change your Home Course

- 1) Proceed to the Golf Life Management system and navigate to your personal Home Page.



- 2) Click on **MY HOME COURSE EDIT**. If your home course is not in the drop down box, click on Search Course Directory and search for your home course. Once you have located your course, click in the Select box to the left of the course name. Then, click on the SELECT button at the bottom of the screen to specify that course as your home course.

NOTE: You must allow popups for the search window to load.

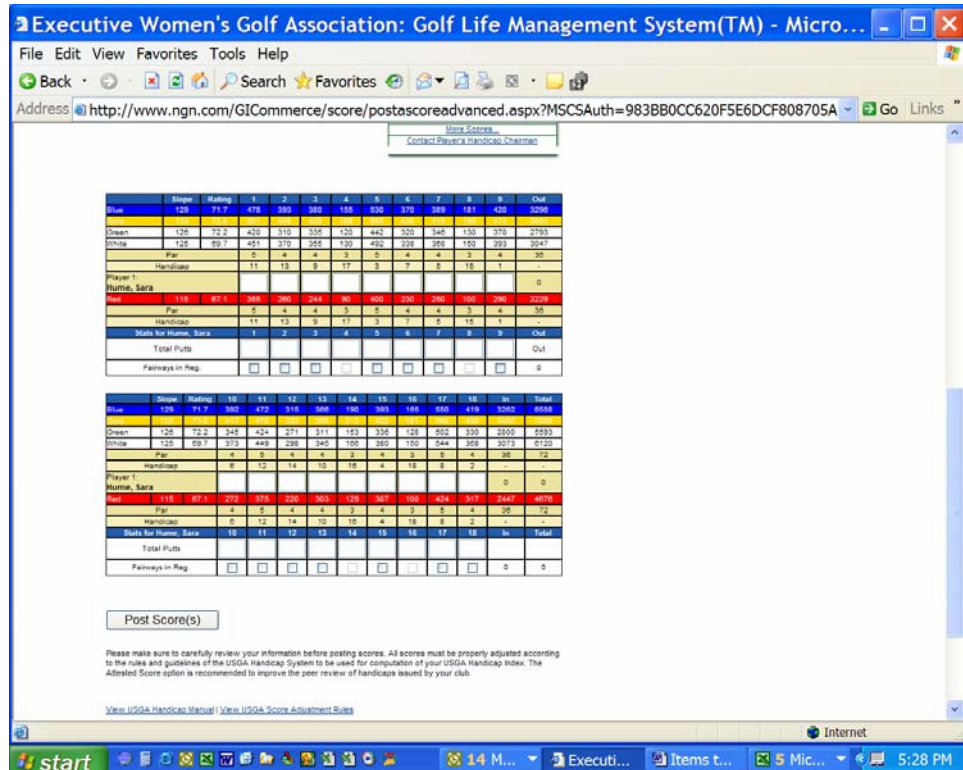

- a) To post a hole-by-hole score **POST HOLE-BY-HOLE SCORE** and enter the following:
 - i) The date
 - ii) Select a course from your personal course list or search the course directory
 - iii) Choose which statistics to track such as total putts, fairways hit, etc.
 - iv) Select Go To Scorecard and enter the hole-by-hole information.
 - v) NOTE: To post hole by hole scores, a correct scorecard for your favorite course needs to be in the course database. Help us keep the database up to date by letting us know any updates needed for any courses that you play.



- b) To post a score when the course is not found in the current database, select **Course not found – enter manually** from the Course Name dropdown box. Enter the information from POST TOTAL SCORE above with the addition of the Course Rating and Slope. (NOTE: you can not enter a hole-by-hole score for a course not found)

1. This system uses popups, please configure your browser to allow popups from this site.
2. If your internet access is through a dial up modem rather than a high speed connection there could be delays in screens loading. We are working on improving the access speed for all areas of the system.
3. If you had your handicap with your Chapter – your scoring records have been imported although your tournament scores may be missing – contact your state golf association to obtain your tournament scoring records if you do not have them or contact golf_life@ewga.com
4. The system has been released to four Chapters only, there are some parts of the system that will continue to be updated over the next few weeks.
